



ZOHLER-SOBEL ENTERTAINMENT

This Entertainment Contract is made effective as of *(Today's Date)* _____, by and between "Client", of *(Client's Name)* _____ and Zohler-Sobel Entertainment, of 8802 Pine Bay Ct., Orlando, FL 32825. In this Contract the party who is contracting to receive this service shall be referred to as "Client", and the party who will be providing the services shall be referred to as "ZSE".

1. **DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES.** Beginning on *(Date of Event)* _____, ZSE will provide the following services (collectively, the Service): As per attached Event Proposal Document.
2. **PAYMENT OF SERVICES.** "Client" will pay compensation to ZSE for the Services in the amount of _____. The compensation shall be payable _____ for Deposit, and _____ payable upon Date of Event or any time prior to the start of the event. An event booking is not considered firm until deposit is received. Bookings may be cancelled at any time; however deposit will be forfeited if the booking is cancelled less than 2 months prior to the event.
3. **RELATIONSHIP TO THE PARTIES.** It is understood by both parties that ZSE is an independent contract with respect to "Client", and not an employee of "Client". "Client" will not provide fringe benefits, including health insurance benefits, paid vacation, or any other employee benefit, for the benefit of ZSE.
4. **ENTIRE CONTRACT.** This Contract contains the entire contract of the parties, and there are no promises or conditions in any other agreement whether oral or written.
5. **OVERTIME.** The Client may request that ZSE continue services longer than the time frame specified in the attached Event Proposal. ZSE will play longer than timeframe specified at an overtime hourly rate of \$100.00 or a rate negotiated between Client and ZSE Staff. Overtime availability is not guaranteed.
6. **OUTCOME.** ZSE is not responsible for the outcome of the event, and does not guarantee any certain level of satisfaction or enjoyment by all attendees.
7. **DAMAGES.** The Client accepts full liability for all damages to any equipment in the possession of any ZSE employee that occur as a result of intentional or un-intentional actions, or neglect upon the part of the client or his/her guests, patrons, customers, students, and so forth. If the setup location is outside, Client agrees to provide adequate shelter, to protect equipment from adverse weather conditions.
8. **REIMBURSEMENT.** In the unlikely event that a catastrophic mechanical failure should occur to the Disc Jockey's equipment and he/she becomes unable to provide the Client with agreed upon services, ZSE agrees to reimburse Client for all amounts paid up to date. Reimbursement also covers illnesses or injuries to the Disc Jockey/ Entertainer before or during an event.
9. **SEVERABILITY.** IF any provision of this Contract shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and enforceable. If a court finds that any provision of this Contract is invalid or unenforceable, but by limiting such provision it would become valid and enforceable, then such provision shall be deemed to be written construed, and enforced as so limited

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10. This agreement Contract shall be governed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida

11. This contract may not be modified in any matter unless it is presented in writing and is signed by both parties. This document and any attachments constitute the entire agreement between the parties. This Contract binds and benefits both parties and any successors.

By signing, the client acknowledges and confirms that he/she has read, and agreed to the terms and conditions set forth in this contract agreement.
